Under Kim's direction the Center has expanded services to include more seniors in Yarnell and the surrounding communities. The dining room at lunch time and its friendly environment is great place to meet and make friends.

Through Kim's vision the center has become a great place to meet and share ideas. She has worked to expand community resources through opening the center to activities and resources that focus on educating the community. Kim has kept an open door policy by inviting anyone with an idea, need, smile or a few hours to volunteer to stop in and visit.

In addition to her dedication to the Community Center, Kim identified the unmet needs of Seniors in the community who were struggling to keep their companion animals at home when faced with medical and financial hardships. In 2012 she launched Petey's Playground, a non-profit, foster-based pet rescue supporting seniors with those difficulties. Petey's provides foster or permanent placement, training and assessment to improve the quality of life of seniors and their pets.

This June, Kim will be leaving the Yarnell Regional Community Center to pursue her other life visions and dreams and will continue to nurture Petey's Playground residents.
